A member from the oral healthcare team will arrange sessions for remote oral health check-in for each child and young person with the appropriate person at the SES

A member from the oral healthcare team will inform the liason at the SES as to how the consultation will take place (phone or video)

Consent should be gained from parents/guardians /young people to have a remote oral health check-in

form, mouth check and pre-remote oral health check-in questionnaire should be completed for each child and young person and returned to the oral healthcare team prior to the date set for the ROHC

Medical history

All confidential data to be shared between oral healthcare team and SES via Microsoft Teams

On average, ROHC should take 20-30 minutes and be held in a confidential space on both sides

Appropriate equipment should be available to complete ROHC e.g. smartphone, tablet, laptop or desktop with in-built cameras

Pen torches may be required for supporting staff at SES to aid looking into the mouth during ROHC
